- The safe operations of any assigned vehicle.

- Perform regular safety checks of the vehicle(s), keep the truck clean and ensure that proper preventative maintenance and lubrication is carried out as required.
- Ensures that safe loading/unloading techniques are followed.
- Maintains truck/associated equipment in a safe, clean and workable condition.
- Maintains current legislated/company required licenses, permits, etc.
- Has good knowledge of the highway traffic Act, practices safe driving techniques and maintains a good driving record.
- Performs a variety of tasks to deliver on an exceptional customer experience.
- Provides general labour and operates equipment safely and efficiently inside and or outside the facility as required
- Provides good housekeeping in and about the facility and within assigned work area.
- Assists with maintenance of equipment and/or vehicles as required
- Monitors inventory and shrink levels if applicable; advises supervisor of discrepancies, as they occur
- Ensures that all associated documentation, including shipping and receiving, is accurate and completed according to schedule
- Understands and follows AGRIS health, safety and environmental policies and procedures required in case of an accident; follows detailed procedures as stipulated.

- Ability to work indoors and outdoors. Physical activity includes walking and climbing, loading/unloading trucks, inspecting equipment, driving, etc.

- Preference given to individuals with a DZ license and heavy equipment experience with a requirement to obtain a DZ license with in three to six months of hire.
