IP Soybean Update

Crop Conditions:

This field looks ok considering some areas were saturated with rain prior to the last report and some plants were recently damaged slightly due to nitrogen being applied. Most of the field is close to full canopy while other sections are slightly delayed to the earlier heavy rains.

This field is very clean with very few weed issues.

Crop Staging:

The majority of the crop is at the R1 stage (at least 1 flower per plant). Like other fields in the area, the crops are progressing nicely but could use a rain.

Weather:

Warm weather has continued over the last 2 weeks with a high of 32°C over the last 2 weeks. Local forecast is calling for chance of rain today. But then nothing again in the forecast for another week or so.
